<p>1. Chair's opening remarks: CF welcomed everyone to the meeting.</p>

<p>4. RAF issues:</p> <p>a. Skate Park: there are still no bins in place. KH is investigating this.</p> <p>b. The Station Commander's annual cocktail party had been held recently. CF queried why one of the Fife councillors and the chair of Guardbridge CC had not been invited (normally they are invited). P'OD did not know why they had been excluded but would raise it at the appropriate meeting.</p> <p>c. There have been further disturbances on a Thursday night with RAF personnel leaving the Rugby Club late at night to go the pubs in the village, knocking on residents' doors and causing a disturbance on the way. There was a general discussion and it was thought that maybe the pub is open too late at night. The way the licensing law is now that if people complain to the licensing authority, when a pub's licence is due for renewal the number and nature of the complaints is considered.</p> <p>d. JE asked if it would be possible for the Mountain Rescue Team to help with clearing the vegetation/weeds from the slates on the Church roof.</p> <p>e.
